### Code of Ethics of the German Chemical Society

The GDCh affirms that it and its members will defend the principles of freedom, tolerance and truth in science, in particular, with respect to upholding and promoting the reputation of chemistry as well as chemical knowledge and know-how. All GDCh-members are aware that, as scientists, they are especially responsible for the effects of their occupation on mankind and nature. With regard to their work, results and effects, they observe applicable laws and international conventions and oppose the abuse of chemistry, e.g. for producing chemical weapons and addictive drugs. Members who disobey these principles damage the reputation of science and of this vocation. They may be excluded from the GDCh.
