Johann August Arfvedson was the chemist who discovered the element lithium while Wilhelm Schlenk is known as a pioneer in organolithium chemistry.

The Arfvedson Schlenk Award intends to honor outstanding scientific and technical achievements in the field of lithium chemistry.

Please submit your nomination for the Arfvedson Schlenk Award 2021 included a short cover letter, a curriculum vitae as well as a list of the TOP 10 publications and other relevant documents to the GDCh office by **19 March 2021**. The nomination can be submitted preferably via the online form at gdch.de/nominations.

Self-applications are not possible.

The award ceremony will take place at the GDCh Chemistry Forum 2021 in Munich. The recipient will receive a medal, a certificate and a monetary prize of 7,500 Euro.
