During the 21st Conference for Inorganic Chemistry, the joint conference of the GDCh Divisions “Solid-state Chemistry & Materials Research” and “Wöhler Association”, the following awards will be presented:

GDCh Division of Solid-state Chemistry & Materials Research

Rudolf-Hoppe Lectureship 2022

Prof. Dr. Rudolf Hoppe (1922-2014; obituary) shaped Solid-state Chemistry like no other with his enormous scientific breadth and his striving for a deep understanding of inorganic structural chemistry based on electrostatic models. In honor of Rudolf Hoppe, the Division has been awarding this name lecture every two years since 2016 to personalities who have achieved outstanding scientific achievements in the field of solid-state chemistry and materials research. The award is linked to an award certificate, a prize money of 1000 euros donated by the Division and an invitation to give four lectures. The first of these lectures usually takes place immediately after the award ceremony on the occasion of the Division conference.

TANIOBIS PhD Award 2022

Sponsored by the companies TANIOBIS (formerly: H.C. Starck Tantalum & Niobium) in even years and H.C. Starck Tungsten in odd years, the Division honors the best doctoral thesis in the field of Inorganic Solid-state Chemistry and Materials Research with this annual prize.

The Wöhler-BASF Young Chemists Award, which is offered by the Wöhler Association for Inorganic Chemistry of the GDCh and supported by BASF SE, will be awarded during the conference.

The Wöhler PhD Award for Inorganic Chemistry 2022 honors the best doctoral thesis in the field of Inorganic Chemistry in 2021. It will be awarded the first time this year.
