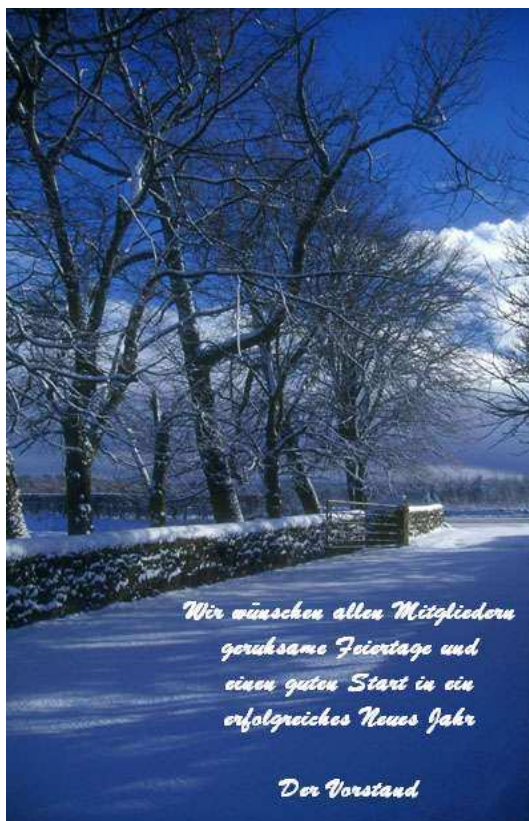

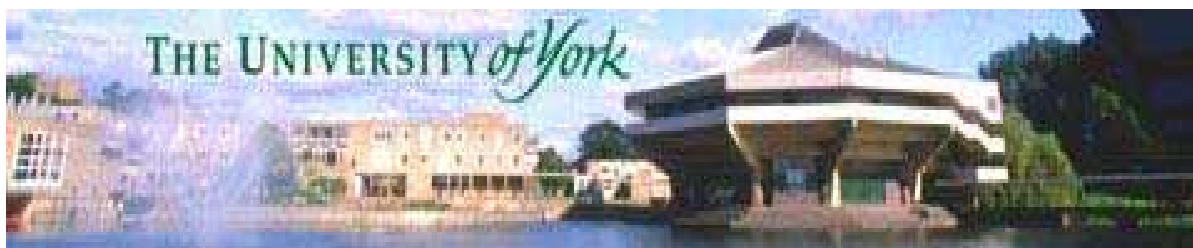
**Joint conference of British NMR-DG, AMPERE and EENC**
