Call for Nominations for the Georg Manecke Prize 2016

The Georg Manecke Foundation supports younger scientists in the field of polymer science, in particular those working on the synthesis and transformation of macromolecular materials and on their biochemical and biotechnological applications.

Georg Manecke, who has his 100th anniversary in 2016, considered rather early to utilize polymer compounds for medical purposes, e.g. for linkage, transport and targeted release of drugs. The foundation is willing to also support applications which pursue these implementations.

The prize is endowed with 7.000 Euro and will be awarded at the conference "Functional Biointerfaces" in Berlin on October 5, 2016. The prize winner will give a lecture on his/her scientific work.

Proposals should consist of a letter in support of the nomination (self-nominations are welcome), a curriculum vitae, and a list of publications.
