Karl Ziegler Prize 2017

The Karl Ziegler Foundation, administered by the Gesellschaft Deutscher Chemiker (GDCh, German Chemical Society) will again award the highly distinguished Karl Ziegler Prize in 2017. This prize honors outstanding scientific achievements in one of the many fields in which Karl Ziegler excelled (including organometallic and inorganic chemistry, organic and applied chemistry, polymer chemistry and catalysis).

The recipient will receive a gold medal and a monetary prize of 50,000 Euro. Thus it represents one of the most endowed prizes awarded by the GDCh. This award is not only bestowed to honor lifetime achievements but also to highlight the research of younger scientists who have already contributed significantly to chemical research through their endeavors.

Nominations for the prize are to be addressed by **March 1, 2017** to b.koehler@gdch.de or by post to the Gesellschaft Deutscher Chemiker, Barbara Köhler, Postbox 90 04 40, 60444 Frankfurt/Main, Germany.

These should include a letter of nomination, the curriculum vitae of the nominee, and other relevant documentation to support the nomination. Self-nominations are not allowed. The prize will be awarded at the next GDCh Chemistry Forum, which will take place in Berlin in September 2017.
